

Onomatopoeia	words that sound like the objects or actions they refer to
Simile	a figure of speech comparing two things using "like" or "as"
Imagery	language that suggests how someone or something looks, sounds, feels, smells, or tastes; helps you create a mental picture
Metaphor	a figure of speech comparing two things by stating that one thing is another thing
Personification	a figure of speech in which objects are given human qualities
Rhyme	two or more words that have the same ending sound
Alliteration	the repetition of words with the same beginning sound
Hyperbole	to make something seem larger or more important than it really is; an exaggeration
Repetition	using the same word or phrase over and over
Stanza	a division of a poem consisting of a series of lines arranged together usually in a repeating pattern of rhythm and rhyme
